### REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF January:

We are visiting congregations established through the labors of Pastor K. John Rao and his wife Sis. Lalithamma. Pastor John's son, Pastor K. Bobby Emmanuel has been well used of the Lord to make our time productive. Three days we were at T.P. Gudur for morning and evening meetings, open air meetings in the
