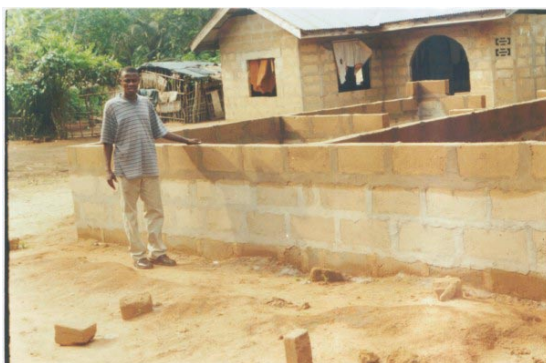
NIGERIA

Calabar 2, Pastor Bassey Ekpe: Attendance = 65 to 82.
